One reason is that too many gender initiatives focus solely on changing women—from the way they network to the way they lead. Another reason is that too many organizations look to women alone to change the organizational practices that maintain the status quo. To accelerate change, we need to stop treating gender as if it were just a woman's burden.

Organizations must enlist both women and men to work together as allies in changing the organizational norms and structures that perpetuate gender gaps"*. But how can we engage men in this common goal?
